The mobility challenges in Mahadevapura can be overcome only when more than 70% of commute is done using Public Transport. I will be a strong advocate for promoting Public transport, Walkability and Cycling.

# **JAL SHAKTHI (WATER MANAGEMENT)**

#### #betterneighbourhood

Access to clean and safe drinking wate for all would be achieved through the Cauvery Stage V Project, Jal Jeevan Mission, Catch the Rain initiative and Kere's rejuvenation.

## Piped drinking water for all

- Additional 100 Million Litres of Cauvery water for Mahadevapura starting from 27. 2024
- 28. 2.5 lakhs additional household will get piped drinking water from Cauvery
- 100% coverage of Functional Household Tap Connection (FHTC) Piped water in 29. rural areas through Jal Jeevan Mission
- 30. Promote water conservation initiatives in partnership with citizens

#### **Treatment of Wastewater**

- 31. Commission Underground Drainage Network in all the 31 Villages in the BBMP Limit by 2024 and based on application
- 5 Fully Functional Sewage Treatment Plants to treat 265 Million Litres of waste 32. water
- 33. Promote decentralised Sewage Treatment Plants in residential complexes and IT Parks to minimise untreated water being discharged into public places, Rajakaulve's and Kere's
- Feasibility study of reuse of the additional water out of recycled water in 34. residential complexes.
- Steps for phase wise construction of UGD in Gram Panchayat areas 35.

### Kere and Kalyani rejuvenation to improve ground water

- 60+ Kere's would be developed with the primary focus of increasing water 36. retention and improving the biodiversity
- 37. Minimise or eliminate the wastewater/Sewage entering the Kere's
- 38. Safeguard the Kere's from any encroachments or dumping of Construction Debris
- 39. Bellandur, Varthur, Ramapura and Yelle mallapa Shetty Kere will be developed as biodiversity and Community engagement space
- 40. Traditional water bodies such as 'Kalyani's' and 'Kuntes' will be resurrected and maintained with the sole purpose of improving the ground water table

#### Rajakaulve's and Keres for flood mitigation

- 135 Kilometres of Rajakaulve's would be developed to manage the rainwater 41. flowing between Kere's
- 42. Sluice Gates will be installed in 16 Key Kere's to manage water levels and mitigate floods
- 43. Promote "CATCH THE RAIN INITIATIVE" to improve the water retention
- 44. Development of Rajakaluves even in rural areas.

## SUSTAINABILITY AND ENVIRONMENT

#### #betterneighbourhood

Mahadevapura Constituency has very high population density and it creates huge constraint on natural resources. However, it is very important to manage development in a sustainable and inclusive way.

#### Improving green cover in Mahadevapura

- 45. Atal Botanical Park in Kannamangala will be developed into a biodiversity park with primarily native plants. Further, Land will be reserved in every BBMP ward and Grama Panchayat to develop parks for public recreation and fitness and also to improve the green cover in the constituency
- Gunjur and Manduru Forest area will be developed as a Tree parks. 46.
- 47. Promote citizen engagement in tree plantation, greening in residential complexes and individual homes.

## SUSTAINABLE GARBAGE MANAGEMENT

### Refuse, Reduce and Reuse will be the 'Mantra' for waste management.

- Ward level Dry Waste Collection Centres (DWCC) at five or more locations 48.
- 49. Each Grama Panchayat will have a 'KASA CENTRE'. This will be equipped to manage and process wet waste, dry waste, Garden waste, rejects, diapers, pads

and E-waste.

- Implement modern Garbage Transfer Stations in 1 or more locations 50.
- 51. Promote decentralised wet waste management in Residential Complexes and IT **Parks**
- We will provide safe and reusable cloth pads/cups to all women and girls. We 52. will train our health workers about benefits of modern practices that promote healthy practises. We have already initiated this program as part of 'Namma Swaccha Kannamangala' on a pilot basis and will soon extend it to other areas too. This is another source of gain full employment for women
- 53. Mahadevapura will completely eliminate Single Use Plastic in line with the clarion call by our Prime Minister Shri Narandra Modiji.
- 54. We will promote preloved stores, repair junctions and Cutlery banks. This will also provide gainful employment to the marginalised section of the society
- 55. Religious places will be declared as zero waste areas and areas around it will be declared as a green zone.
- Priority for more scientific management of the garbage coming from Bangalore. 56.
- 57. Removing the garbage completely at Manduru and transforming this location as a spot for public, sports and cultural activities.
- 58. Capping the land filling in and around Mittaganahalli in Manduru Panchayat and priority to convert it into a park or a Stadium.

### **Prevent indiscriminate Animal waste disposal**

Methodical collection of Animal Waste by the designated agency and scientific 59. disposal of Animal Waste at the Plant under construction at Kannur. This is the first of its kind in Karnataka.

#### **Citizen Engagement Initiatives**

60. Promote citizen engagements in space transformation initiatives, Plogging

- events, Swachh Bharat Initiatives in every neighbourhood
- 61. Promote segregation of garbage at source
- 62. Promote Swachh Bharat and Garbage Segregation awareness initiatives among all School Children.

#### Piped Natural Gas connection to promote sustainability

2 Lakh household will get Piped Natural Gas with an investment of over Rupees 63. 850 Crores

#### Increase coverage of Electric charging stations

Ensure installation of Electric Charging stations across Mahadevapura to 64. promote Electric Vehicles adoption and thus reduce air pollution.

# **PUBLIC, PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP**

Partnerships with Corporates, Non-Governmental organisations like "The Ugly Indians" and Citizens groups in areas such as Education, Health, Environment, public amenities, Keres, parks and space transformation initiatives would be encouraged.

#### **Inspire Citizen Participation**

- JANAHITA APP would be enhanced further to help promote transparency in the 65. works happening in Mahadevapura and help residents report and resolve issues in the neighbourhood.
- Encourage Citizens to collaborate with the administration through active 66. participation in the Ward Committee meetings.

### **Inspire Corporates Participation**

67. Create an annual forum - 'CSR HABBA' for donors and reputable NGOs to meet and engage to quickly enable them to assess needs and agree outcomes

- 68. Engage with specialist agencies and enlist their services for areas such as ground water management, teaching aids, skill development, health care and many more
- Encourage entrepreneurs to invest in and build business that will provide 69. solutions for public benefit. The classic example is waste management. We have engaged with entrepreneurs that are investing in waste management where the Government has provided basic infrastructure of land, power and water..

- Establishing Eelectric crematoria to resolve the issue of burial grounds. 73.

- Enhanced focus on Welfare of Pourakarmikas, Drivers and helpers involved in 76. keeping Mahadevapura clean
- 77. Ensuring all Government Schools and Colleges will be upgraded with better

- Ensuring issue of "Hakkaupathra" to socially underprivileged residents 78.

- Strengthening of infrastructure in Kadugodi and Varthur first grade colleges 84.
- Strengthening of infrastructure in Channasandra and Immdahalli Polytechnics 85.
- Ensure completion of 7 Playgrounds for the benefit of children and youth 86.
- All High Tension Cables will be shifted to Underground cables to improve the 87. reliability and safety in power transmission
- Setting up of additional KPTCL Power stations to enhance the quality and 88. reliability of Power supply

- 93. Promoting People friendly Police stations where stakeholders for varied socioeconomic groups are feeling safe and treated with respect.

## **CULTURE, EDUCATION, EMPLYMENT & SPORTS**

- 94. Priority for construction of International Stadium at Manduru Biomining location covering 20 acres.
- Programmes highlightingf the pride of Kannada and encouraging cultural 95. events.
- Development of indoor auditoria and Rangamandiras at Hoodi, Doddakannelli, 96. Nimbekayipura.
- 97. Availing all Government benefits for Women and elderly.
- 98. Complete support to the Statrt-ups that come up in Mahadevapura.
- 99. Kannada learning campaign already in place for Non-Kannadiga people will be extended to other areas.
- 100. All steps ensuring facilities for training the artists and sportspersons.
- 101. Private Udyoga MELAs for creating job opportunities for eligible and unemployed.
