MPLADS (Member of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme)

Over the past 10 years, 8 months, (MPLADS) funds have been effectively utilized to create durable infrastructure and cater to the needs of the public. Here's a glimpse of the significant achievements:

» Over 300 RO plants have been established across the constituency, providing pure drinking water at nominal rate of ₹5 for 20 liters. This has made pure drinking water accessible and affordable.



» Electric crematoriums have been established in Ramanagara, Channapatna, Magadi, Kunigal and Anekal to ensure respectful last rites of the deceased.



» 80 bus stops have been constructed across the constituency with state-of-the-art technology such as CCTV cameras, solar panels, and charging stations.

» Ambedkar Bhavans have been constructed in several areas of the constituency, to facilitate community building.

» Grant has been released for the construction of the Railway Underbridge in Yarab Nagar, Ramanagara.



Education



» To promote education in rural areas, Kendriya Vidyalaya has been constructed near Kengal, Channapatna and allotted 10 acres. 1- 10th Std classes are functioning successfully.

» 30 acres land has been sanctioned for the construction of Navodaya School in Baradanahalli, Kanakapura taluk and work is in progress.

» PU and Degree Colleges have been sanctioned across the constituency.



» Morarji Desai Residential Schools have been sanctioned and constructed in Kanakapura, Ramanagara, Magadi and Kunigal constituencies.

» Action has been taken for the construction of Hostels for students belonging to backward classes across the constituency.



Government Polytechnic College at Harohalli has been constructed and is operational.



To facilitate state of the art tech and advanced learning, smart classrooms have been introduced in schools till 10th std and in first grade colleges.

With an intent to provide world-class education to children, over 100 CSR-funded Government Model schools are to be established across the constituency at a cost of ₹10 Crore per school. Agreements have been signed for 20 schools and work is in progress. Rest 80 schools are to be constructed in the upcoming days.



Health

300 Bedded Super speciality District Hospital in Ramanagara is fully functional.



» A 100-bedded CSR Infosys funded Maternity and Child Care Hospital has been constructed in Kanakapura at a cost of ₹46 crore.

» A grant of ₹10 crore has been provided from the state government for further infrastructural upgradation.



Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences and Medical College is soon to be a reality in Ramanagara.

» Construction is underway for an CSR Infosys-funded, 100-bed Maternity Hospital in Kunigal.

» Approvals have been received for the construction of a Government Medical College in Kanakapura, with work beginning shortly.

» Grants have been sanctioned for the construction of a 200-bedded ESI hospital in Bommasandra in Anekal with work beginning shortly.



» Approval obtained for building a 200-bed ESI hospital in Harohalli industrial area; construction to start post-central government funds release.

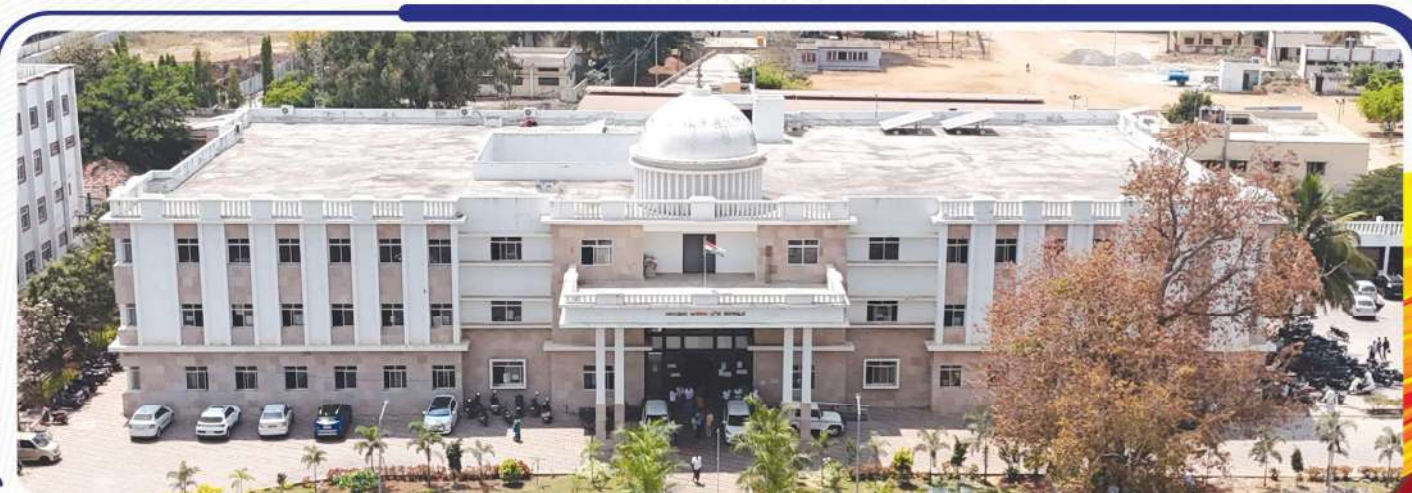
» Various steps have been taken to enhance Rural and Urban Primary Health Care facilities across the constituency, ensuring good health for all.

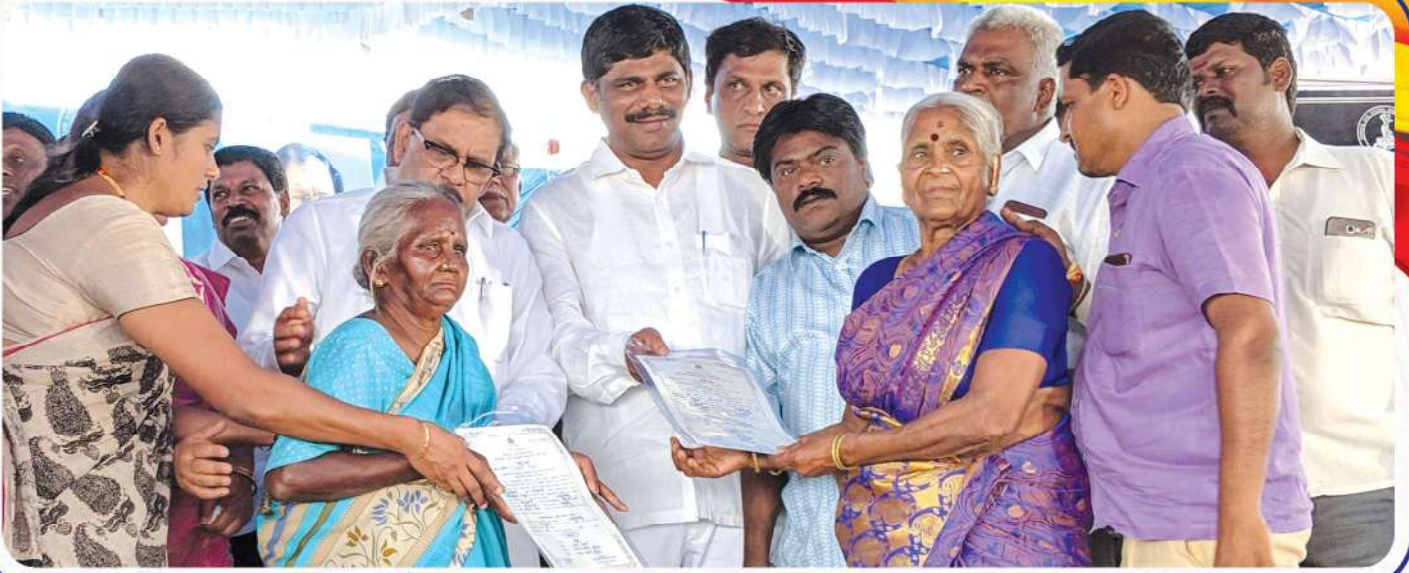


Revenue

» New Kandaya Bhavanas (Mini Vidhana Soudha) have been established in Kunigal and Kanakapura.

» Land reserved and sanctioned for burial grounds in over 200 villages across Ramanagara district.





» Efforts underway to provide occupancy certificates under sections 94C and 94CC to residents who have built houses illegally on government land in Anekal, Rajarajeshwari Nagar, and Bangalore South Assembly Constituency.

» Through DKS Charitable Trust, support is extended to over 26,668 senior citizens, widows, differently abled and other eligible persons to apply and benefit from various government schemes.



» For the first time in the state, a team of 60 land surveyors have started working in Ramanagara district to solve various problems faced by farmers in the revenue department.

» Construction of Kandaya Bhavana is underway in Magadi, Anekal, and Harohalli.

» Classification of new sub-revenue villages to ensure access to government facilities for rural residents, along with the distribution of e-assets under the Svamitva scheme.

Cooperation sector

Massive Milk Powder manufacturing unit sanctioned and established near Kanwa, Channapatna by KMF.



» Mega Milk Dairy has been built in Shivanahalli, Kanakapura in collaboration with BAMUL and is fully functioning.

» BAMUL is overseeing the construction of 124 Bulk Milk Coolers (BMCs) to reduce transportation costs and store quality milk to benefit local farmers.

» Cooperative societies are providing zero-interest loans to farmers, facilitating agricultural development and empowerment.

» Stree Shakti Self-Help groups are facilitating zero-interest loans of up to ₹5 lakh to women, empowering them financially.



Irrigation



» The Sathanur-Kailancha project with a cost of ₹155 crore and an aim to fill water in 27 lakes across Kanakapura and Ramanagara taluk in three stages is operational.

» The left bank and right banks of the Kanva Reservoir in Channapatna taluk has been modernized at a cost of ₹38 crore.



Under NREGA and Irrigation Department, several check dams have been constructed across the constituency.



With a project cost of 240 crores, approval has been given to replenish 67 lakes in Anekal taluk, as well as Rahutanahalla and Mavattur lakes in Kanakapura taluk, utilizing treated wastewater from the K&C Valley treatment plant in Bangalore city.





» With an aim to fill 63 lakes of Magadi and 17 lakes of Kunigal, the Shri Ranga Lift Irrigation project has been implemented at a cost of ₹450 crore.

» Work is in progress to supply water to lakes of Kunigal and Magadi taluks through 'Link Canal' from Hemavathi Branch Canal. This been taken up at a cost of ₹986 crore.



» The revitalisation work of Garakahalli Lift Irrigation Project in Channapatna taluk has been sanctioned at a cost of ₹43 crore and work is in progress.

» ₹540 crore has been approved for supplying drinking water to Ramanagara by diverting water from the dam near Sattigala to Igglur barrage through Kanva, Manchanabele and YG Gudda reservoirs.

» Project to fill 147 lakes in Bidadi and Harohalli of Ramanagara at a cost of ₹146 Crore is underway.



» Micro drip irrigation works worth ₹70 crore for 8 villages of Uyyamballi and Doddalahalli Hobli of Kanakapura Taluk Jackwell work have been completed and pump house work is in progress.

» Approval has been given to fill 21 lakes of Uyyamballi and Doddalahalli from Kaveri River at a cost of ₹108 Crore



» Project for Construction of Diversion Canal and Weir for Byramangala Reservoir in Ramanagara Taluk at a cost of ₹110 Crore.

» Under the Narayanpur lake filling project, the work of filling water from Arkavati river to Narayanpur and 11 other lakes of Kanakapura taluk at a cost of ₹27 crore is in progress.

» A ₹70 crore project is in progress to fill Garalapura and 13 other lakes in Kanakapura taluk with water from the back water of Arkavati Reservoir in two phases through Lift irrigation.

» Under SIMP, a project for modernization of Manchanabele canal is planned at a cost of ₹281 crore.



» ₹156 crore has been sanctioned for beautification of the left and right banks of the Arkavathi River in Ramanagara. This also includes construction of a park, fountain, footpath and a children's park.

» Irrigation project costing ₹28 crore has been sanctioned by the Minor Irrigation Department to lift water from Arkavathi river near Kalegowdanadoddi in Ramanagara taluk to Bolappanahalli, Arehalli, Bilagumba and other lakes in Ramanagara taluk and the work is in the starting stage.



Urban Development

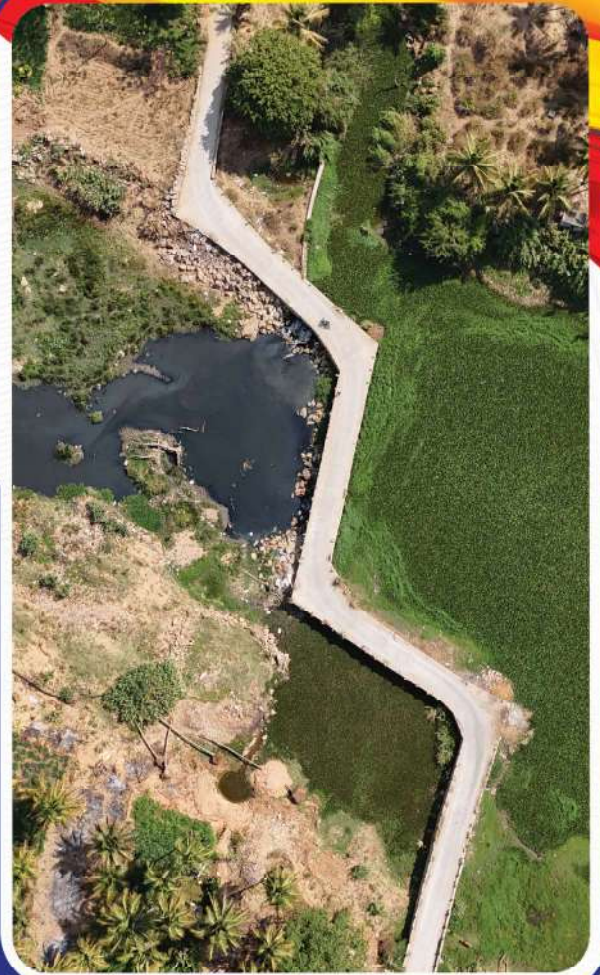


» Great emphasis has been given to build roads, drains, bridges and provide basic amenities in Urban areas such as RR Nagar and Bangalore South constituency.

» Grants have been provided to better basic infrastructure, drainage works and drinking water under city councils, municipalities and town panchayats.

» ₹125 crore has been approved for the construction of roads and drains under Ramanagara Municipal Council.

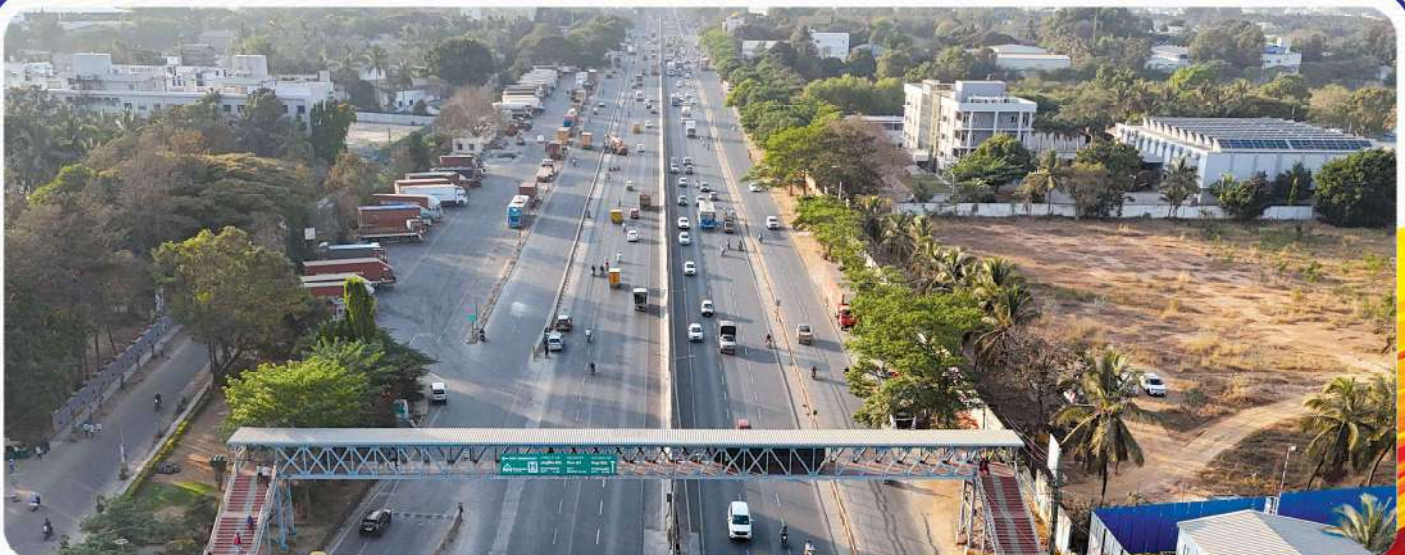
» Efforts underway to provide drinking water supply to 110 villages across Ramanagara, Channapatna, Rajarajeshwari Nagara, Bangalore South constituencies by August 15th, 2024.



» A plan has been drawn up to extend the existing metro connectivity to the following towns and action has been taken to get the performance report.

- » From Bommasandra to Attibele.
- » From Gottigere via Jigani to Anekal- Attibele-Sarjapur.
- » From Kanakapura Road Silk Institute to Harohalli.
- » From Challaghatta to Bidadi on Mysore Road.

» Brainstorming and efforts to ensure long term solutions and reduce traffic congestion in Bengaluru.



Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (Drinking water supply and road construction)

Rural Drinking Water Sanitation Organization (KRWS)

» Under Rural Drinking Water Sanitation Organization (KRWS) multi-village drinking water scheme, Cauvery drinking water project for Kodihalli and other 298 villages of Kanakapura taluk worth ₹210 crore is in progress and nearing completion.

» Under the Multi Village Drinking Water Scheme, water supply projects for 257 inhabited areas in Harohalli taluk and 77 inhabited areas in Bangalore South have been approved and are in the tender stage.

» ₹456 crore has been approved to provide drinking water supply to Ramanagara and 8 villages from Netkal Reservoir.



» Under the Multi Village Drinking Water Scheme, drinking water facilities to 251 villages of Channapatna taluk from Kanwa reservoir at a cost of ₹300 crore is in the approval stage.

» To provide drinking water to 745 households under the multi-village drinking water scheme from Markonahalli Dam in Kunigal taluk is under progress and the ₹465 crore project is under progress.





» Under the Multi Village Drinking Water Scheme, 288 communities in Anekal, Attibele, Bommasandra, Chandapura, and Hebbagodi will receive access to clean water. The project, totaling ₹1210 crore, aims to ensure safe drinking water for these areas.

» Under the NRLM (National Rural Livelihood Mission) scheme, credit facilities and grants have been provided to self-help societies and women groups.

» Under Pradhana Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) and CMGSY roads have been developed at a cost of ₹50 crore.

» In Ramanagara, Channapatna, Kanakapura, Magadi, and Kunigal assembly constituencies rural roads and drains have been developed. These projects worth ₹50 Crore is funded by the Chief Minister's special grant and NREGA funds.



» During the year 2023-24, ₹55 crore worth road and drainage development work has been sanctioned for Ramanagara, Channapatna, Kanakapura and Kunigal assembly constituencies under CM Special Grants.



MGNREGA

Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act



National Award for effective implementation of MGNREGA.



Under NREGA various developmental works have been taken up such as: Construction of more than 3,000 check dams, development of Kalyani, rejuvenation of lakes, construction of agricultural ponds, construction of dams, promotion of horticultural crops, development of burial grounds, construction of school compound, development of playgrounds, construction of concrete roads in rural areas and various individual and community works including construction of drains, construction of toilets and over 1 lakh cow sheds. Adequate efforts have been made for the prosperity of farmers to facilitate rural development.

Power

When Shri D.K.Shivakumar was the Energy Minister, 66/11 KV Substations have been established in over 40 areas to provide quality and continuous electricity in towns and rural areas across Anekal, Kunigal, Ramanagara district.

» The installation of 220/66/11 KV power sub-station in Kottipura, Ramanagara town which was held up, has been sped and electricity issue has been solved in Ramanagara.



» 66/11 KV sub-station have been upgraded to 220 KV sub-station in Channapatna town, resolving electricity issues.

» A new 220/66/11 KV power sub-station has been constructed in Harohalli Industrial Area, providing convenience to the industrial area and Harohalli Taluk.



140 MW solar power production has been established at various places in the constituency.

» Continuous power supply has been provided to all the villages under the Deen Dayal Upadhyaya scheme.

» Under the leadership of Shri D K Shivakumar as Energy Minister, over 100,000 pump sets have been installed under UNIP and HVDS scheme. This has benefitted several farmers across the constituency.



» 400 KV Power Transmission Supply Station of KPTCL has been approved at a cost of ₹392 crore at Huliurdurga Hobli Center in Kunigal and work is in progress.

» Action has been taken to establish transformers by BESCOM in cases pending over 5 years.

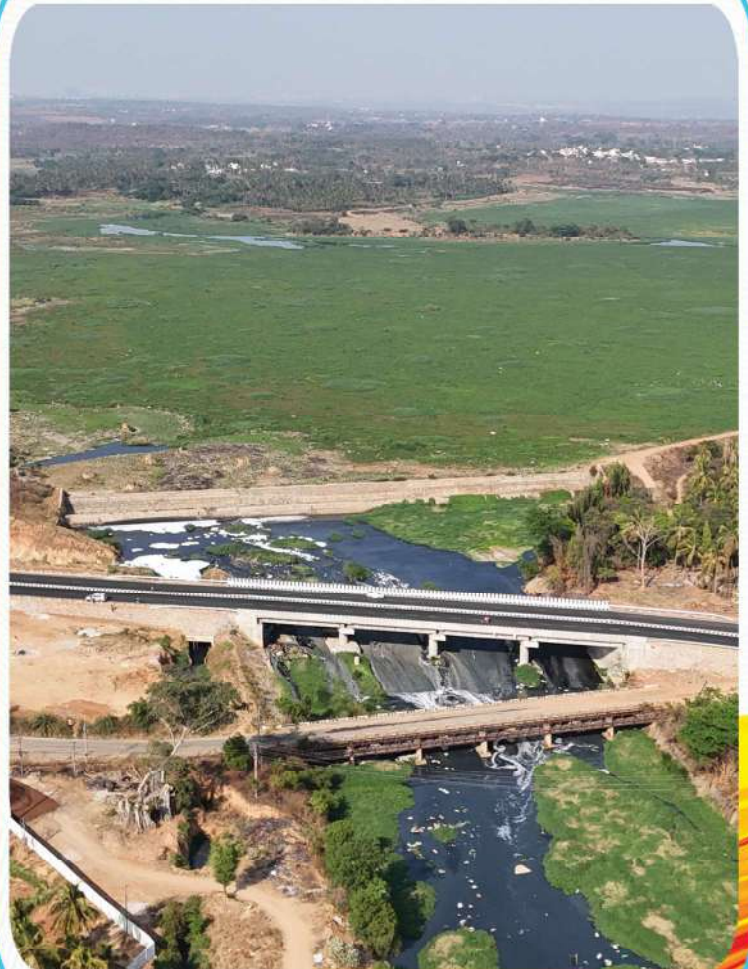
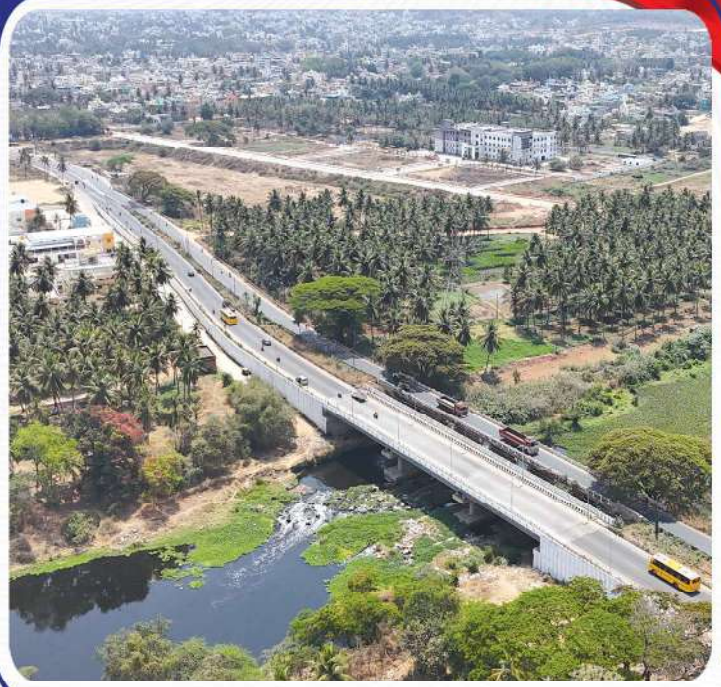


» Construction of solar substations to supply power to farmers during the day under the Kusum-C project has been implemented. Approval granted for a 160-megawatt electricity generation project, and work is currently underway.

» BESCOM technical staff training center has been established at Archakarahalli, Ramanagara.

Public Works Department (Roads and Bridges)

- » Grants have been sanctioned by National Highway Development Authority for main road development in Ramanagara, Channapatna, and Bidadi and work is in progress.
- » Widening and development of main roads in Kaggalipura, Harohalli, and Kanakapura city are underway.
- » Land acquisition for the construction of Satellite Town Ring Road (STRR) road in Magadi, Ramanagara, Kanakapura, and Anekal is in progress.



- » Priority has been given for the construction of roads and bridges in Ramanagara, Channapatna, Kanakapura, Magadi, Kunigal, and Anekal town areas.
- » KRDCCL is developing a road via Bidadi, Harohalli, Jigani, Anekal, Varthur, Whitefield connecting to the International Airport.

» Road development project from Nice Road to Magadi, Huliurdurga, led by KSHIP, is nearing completion.

» Road development projects worth ₹500 crore have been executed across Kanakapura, Magadi, Ramanagara, and Channapatna taluks under PWD, CRF and Panchayat Raj Departments.



» Administrative approval has been obtained for the fiscal year 2023-24 to develop main roads in Anekal and Bangalore South Assembly Constituency, with a budget of ₹16 crore already allocated and tenders issued.

» A grant of ₹5.4 crore has been sanctioned for the development of the Maranayakanahalli road, bordering Tamil Nadu, under Anekal.



» A grant of ₹7 crore has been allocated and administrative approval has been obtained for the construction of a new auditorium in Magadi Assembly Constituency.

» An estimated grant of ₹30 crore has been provided for land acquisition to facilitate the widening of district and state highway roads within the constituency.

Transport

» Under Shakti Yojana, additional Ashwamedha buses have been provided across the constituency to facilitate women travelers.

» KSRTC bus stops have been constructed at Kodamballi in Channapatna taluk and Kodihalli in Kanakapura taluk.



» Well-equipped KSRTC bus stand and commercial complex is under construction in Kanakapura Town.

» KSRTC bus stand has been constructed in Huliurdurga town.



» Grant has been sanctioned for a private bus stand in Kunigal town and tenders invited for the work.

» Through DKS Charitable Trust, measures have been taken to provide training and distribution of driving licenses to more than 25,000 people from economically weaker sections.

Tourism

» ₹2.5 crore has been allocated for the development of Huttaridurga hill in Kunigal taluk.

» Sri Kabbalamma temple has been fully developed and made into a major tourist destination in Kabbal village of Kanakapura taluk.



» A grant of ₹25 crore has been sanctioned for the development of the deathplace of NadaPrabhu Kempegowda in Kempapura village of Magadi taluk.

» The development of Magadi Fort built by Nadaprabhu Kempegowda is prioritized with a grant of ₹20 crore.

» ₹25 crore allocated for the comprehensive development of Veerapur village in Magadi taluk, the birthplace of Shri Shivakumar Swamiji.

» ₹25 crore was allocated for the comprehensive development of Banandur village in Bidadi Hobli, the birthplace of Sri Balagangadharnath Swamiji of Sri Adichunchangiri Maha Sansthan Mutt.

» Construction of Yatri Nivas in Sangama, Elgalli and Maralebekuppe villages of Kanakapura.



Housing



- » More than 15,000 houses have been sanctioned under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana, Basava Awas Yojana, and Ambedkar Housing Yojana for the economically weaker sections.
- » Steps have been taken to provide more than 10,000 free plots to the homeless in Ramanagara, Magadi and Kunigal assembly constituencies.



- » Houses built by the Slum Development Board have been allotted to eligible beneficiaries. Efforts are underway to issue title deeds by December 2024 in the Bangalore South and RR Nagar Assembly Constituencies
- » A total of 9,042 houses have been constructed by the Slum Development Board across Ramanagara, Channapatna, Kanakapura, Magadi, Kunigal, and Bidadi towns, benefiting eligible beneficiaries.

Forestry

» Under the Forest Rights Act, in collaboration with the Forest and Social Welfare departments, efforts have been made to provide ownership deeds to traditional farmers.

» Steps have been taken to obtain land tenancy under the Forest Rights Act for farmers who have been cultivating on forest land since before 1976. An IA has been filed in the Supreme Court for approval.

Additionally, pending proposals are undergoing survey work with efforts to expedite the release of forest lands.



» Farmers of Hakki-Pikki and Iruliga communities have been allotted 350 acres of land in Ragihalli State Forest under Bannerghatta.

» A special grant of ₹50 crore has been sanctioned for the construction of a railway barricade from Bannerghatta National Park to the Muthathi forest area to prevent man - animal conflicts.

Sports

Modern well-equipped sports stadiums have been constructed at the cost of ₹5 crore each in Bangalore South's Begur, Kunigal and Kanakapura constituencies.



New sports stadium has been constructed at a cost of ₹2 crore in Kodihalli village of Kanakapura taluk.



» The district stadium in Ramanagar is set to undergo development, with an initial allocation of ₹5 crore in the first phase.

» ₹2 crore has been sanctioned for the development of ground within Kudur's PU College premises.





» ₹10 crore Grant released for the development of the sports stadium in Anekal town.

» To support athletes from Bangalore and nearby areas, plan to build an "International Stadium" on a 60-acre site near Indlavadi, Anekal, is currently under approval.

» Several steps have been taken to promote sports in Rajarajeshwari Nagar and Bangalore South constituencies.

Sericulture

» ₹75 crore has been allocated for the development of a state-of-the-art silk cocoon market near Vandaraguppe, Channapatna. This initiative aims to support Ramanagara silk growers by providing them with a conducive marketplace. Additionally, efforts are underway to secure ₹125 crore in the second phase for further enhancements.

» With the support of the State Government, a new Silk Market has been established in Kanakapura.



Covid-19

» During the Covid-19 pandemic, unable to see farmers' plight, over 10,000 tonnes of produce were purchased by DKS Charitable Trust and distributed across the constituency.

» Masks, Sanitiser, Medical Kits, Food kits were distributed along with the provision of oxygen concentrators and important injections.

» Visited hospitals to uplift the spirits of COVID patients, offering them comfort and support during challenging times.

» Leaving behind the fear of the virus, last rites of the victims were done with utmost respect and care.



In the last 10 years, 'Janasamparka Sabhe' meetings have been held across the constituency and on spot solutions have been given.
