





Karnataka High Court, on Dec 17, 2015, mandated the "2 bins and 1 bag" system be adopted by all waste generators in Bengaluru.

Daily collection of organic, sanitary. Biweekly of recyclables.

# Know the SWM Men & Material

### Door to Door Collection & Transportation (D2D C&T)





### **Functions of PKs**

#### **BBMP D2D Collection**

- Daily Collection and Transportation by Auto Tippers ONLY with Driver & Helper
- Push Cart Collection ONLY in Slum Areas

#### **BBMP Street Sweeping**

- SCOPE Sweeping of roads, streets, footpaths and pavements. Cleaning of tertiary road side drains, uprooting of vegetation.
- Pourakarmikas to carry out the street sweeping
- Gangwork for intensive cleaning of public areas like playgrounds, burial grounds etc.





# Know the Waste Picker

Inclusion in Municipal SWM functions

- •Direct MOU with Municipality to operate the Dry waste Collection Centres
- •Trained for operating bio methanization units at ward level
- •Empanelling wastepickers and scrap dealers as legal service providers for bulk generators

•Scientific bin system for commercial market areas & Slum areas to streamline the irregular waste collection.

Placement of litter bins for commercial areas/market area/area with high floating population
Elimination of Black spots along with beautification Approximately there are 2000 large black spots About 200 black spots have been removed by BBMP and citizen iniatives. To beautify under PPP mode about 50% can be borned by BBMP and 50 % from the citizen







Lorry Point Specifications:

- Area 270 to 300 sq.m.
- Should not be at crossroad or junction/main road area
- Preferably with a roof cover
- No Garbage on Ground
- Only Tipping and/or transfer from bin



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
